



GLAMORGAN WANDERERS R.F.C

Glamorgan Wanderers R.F.C. was formed in 1893 by a group of ex-pupils from Monkton House School, and the club was originally known as Old Monktonians.

ground in Whitchurch a suburb of Cardiff and the players used were suitably christened as home games were played on no less than seven different grounds. In 1919 the club found a permanent the local Three Elms Hotel. as the membership of the club had broadened and the Wanderers In 1913 the club's name was changed to Glamorgan Wanderers

In 1923 the Wanderers Club Limited was founded in Cardiff's Wyndham Arcade. This was one of the first such clubs to be formed in Wales and its unique atmosphere attracted Rugby afficionades from all over the world. Unfortunately the club was closed in 1969 and is still mourned by many people.

In 1950 the Wanderers were forced to move from Whitchurch to their existing ground at St. Fagans Court, which was named the Memorial Ground and dedicated to all the Wanderers who had

Last season, 1985/86, was the most successful in the clubs history. The Wanderers finished Runners-up to Pontypool in both the Whitbread Merit Table and the Western Mail Champdied during the wars.

For the first time the Wanderers scored 1,000 points in a season a total which included 164 tries. A new club record of 324 points was scored by full-back Mark Hembury which was the third The Wanderers were runners-up to Newport in the Snelling Sevens, only to go one better this season when they won the tournament by defeating Cardiff in the final. highest points score in Welsh Rugby. Nick Ward scored a new club record of 28 tries also making him third in the scoring list.

This season the Wanderers are still placed towards the top of the Whitbread Merit Table and the Western Mail Championship having lost only 4 games.
