## GLAMORGAN WANDERERS R.F.C.



Glamorgan Wanderers R.F.C. was formed in 1893 by a group of ex-pupils from Monkton House School, and the club was originally known as Old Monktonians.

In 1913 the club's name was changed to Glamorgan Wanderers as the membership of the club had broadened and the Wanderers were suitably christened as home games were played on no less than seven different grounds. In 1919 the club found a permanent ground in Whitchurch a suburb of Cardiff and the players used the local Three Elms Hotel.

In 1923 the Wanderers Club Limited was founded in Cardiff's Wyndham Arcade. This was one of the first such clubs to be formed in Wales and its unique atmosphere attracted Rugby aficionados from all over the world. Unfortunately the club was closed in 1969 and is still mourned by many people.

In 1950 the Wanderers were forced to move from Whitchurch to their existing ground at St. Fagans Court, which was named the Memorial Ground and dedicated to all the Wanderers who had died during the wars.

Last season, 1985/86, was the most successful in the clubs history. The Wanderers finished Runners-up to Pontypool in both the Whitbread Merit Table and the Western Mail Championship.

For the first time the Wanderers scored 1,000 points in a season a total which included 164 tries. A new club record of 324 points was scored by full-back Mark Hembury which was the third highest points score in Welsh Rugby. Nick Ward scored a new club record of 28 tries also making him third in the scoring list.

The Wanderers were runners-up to Newport in the Snelling Sevens, only to go one better this season when they won the tournament by defeating Cardiff in the final.

This season the Wanderers are still placed towards the top of the Whitbread Merit Table and the Western Mail Championship having lost only 4 games.

Other players to watch for in the Wanderers team are Scrum-half Gerald Williams who won international honours for Wales, with his then club partner at Bridgend, Gary Pearce; No. 8 Owain Williams, who played for the Barbarians last season; wing Andy Francis, who would have been in this year's Welsh Trial but was forced to withdraw because of illness and Club Captain and prop-forward Paul Prickett who has appeared in over 300 games for the Wanderers.

### LLANDOVER R.F.C.



The history of the Welsh Rugby Union will show that Rugby Football was first played at Llandover well over a hundred years ago. Old residents used to recall how a drover gave vivid descriptions of the game as it was played at Blackheath, and these drovers used to move cattle from all parts of West Wales through Llandover. It is clear however that the game was not welcomed with whole hearted enthusiasm—a strong Puritan element within the town objected to this 'barbaric pastime'. So as not to offend the town inhabitants the game was often played by moonlight in a field adjoining the town — let us hope that today's game will finish in better light!

However sufficient interest in the game continued in Llandover to be represented at the inaugural meeting of the Welsh Rugby Union held at Neath on March 12th, 1881.

Llandover R.F.C. was granted the status of a W.R.U. club again in 1957 and later the Club was admitted to the West Wales Rugby Union (in 1965). Since then Llandover has performed with increasing success, climbing through the league to Section A (in 1983-84).

An inscribed silver tankard to Llandover's man of the match will be presented by Mr. Gwyn Griffith the manager of National Westminster Bank (Llandover Branch).

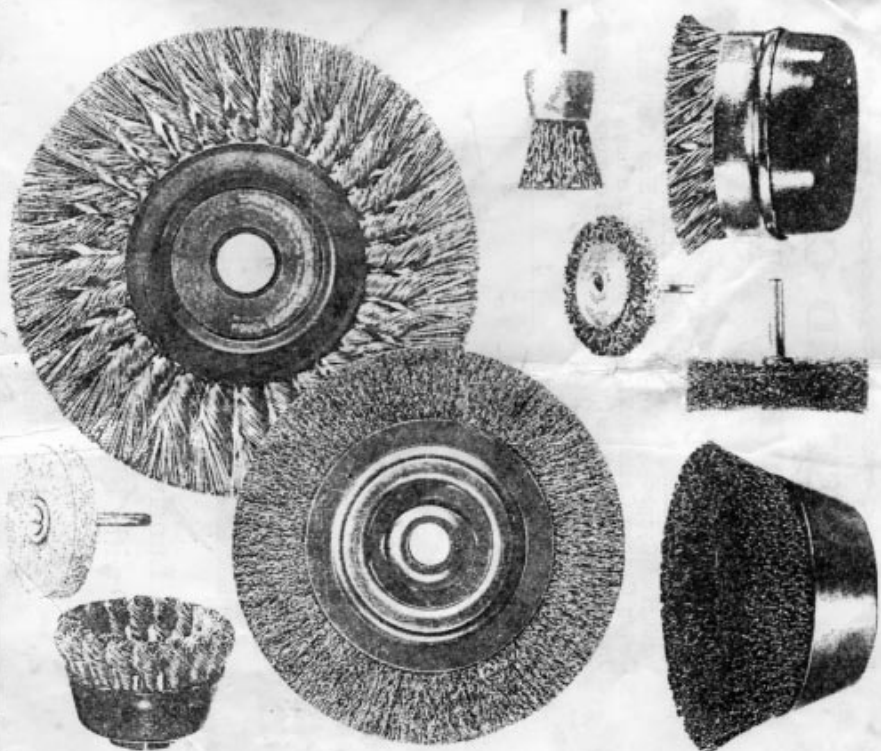
