LLANDOVERY RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB

1. Name

The name of the Club shall be THE LLANDOVERY TOWN RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB.

2. Objects

The objects of the Club Shall be to promote, encourage and foster the game of the Rugby Union Football in the locality of the Town. The Club shall be affiliated to the Welsh Rugby Union, The West Wales Union and The Junior Union, whose playing rules, bye-laws and professional laws shall be followed at all times.

The official colours of the Club shall be red and white and green and white.

Membership

The membership of the Club shall be as follows:-

- (b) Vice-President
- Life Members
- Patrons
- Playing Members

who shall pay an annual subscription fee as agreed by the Annual General Meeting. No

person can be considered a member unless he has paid the current subscription.

The Committee has the power to refuse membership to any individual on the grounds that acceptance could be detrimental to the well being, character and sporting spirit of the Club.

5. Life Membership

Life Membership can be bestowed on a mem-Life Membership can be bestowed on a mem-ber for outstanding services to the Club. A Life Member shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting on the nomination of the Committee and shall have all the privileges entitled to any member of the Committee.

The Committee shall consist of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Fixture Secretary and members, all elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Committee shall have the following powers:

- (a) To control and transact all the business of the Club.
- (b) To co-opt any additional members if
- To appoint from Club Members, five trustees in whom shall be vested all the Club's properties and monies.
- (d) To expel or suspend any member whose conduct and action is prejudicial to the Club or to the Welsh Rugby Union.

- To appoint sub-committees when required. The sub-committees, to whom plenary powers may be given, to report to the Executive Committee.
- To recommend to the Annual General Meeting any amendments, alterations, etc. to the Constitution of the Club.

There shall be a quorum of one third at the There shall be a quorum of one third at the Committee meetings. No member shall be absent from four consecutive meetings without reasons acceptable to the Committee. Failure to do so automatically removes the member from office and the Committee shall appoint another in his place.

7. Income and Accounts

Income shall be obtained by means of members subscriptions, gate monies, grants and by other recognised legal means.

Club accounts shall be kept in Lloyds Bank and all cheques to be signed by Hon. Treasurer and one other official as approved by the Com-

Any profit accruing from the running of the Club shall be devoted to the furtherance of the game of rugby in the locality.

8. Insurance

Playing members and properties shall be insured by a reputable insurance agency. The

Club shall also take out a Public Liability

9. Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting shall be held in the month of May and fourteen days notice shall be given. Twenty members shall constitute a quorum for this meeting, wherein the business shall include: shall include:-

- The election of President, Life Members, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Fixture Secretary, Hon. Treasurer; Assistant Hon. Treasurer, Members of the Committee and the Auditor.
- (b) To receive and approve the annual statement of accounts.
- To receive and discuss amendments, additions and alterations to the Club's Constitution.
- (d) To discuss any other matters of immediate and relevant importance to the Club and Rugby Union Football.
- The Captain to be selected by all members present at the meeting.

Nominations, notices of motion, resolutions, etc. must be submitted by two club members (proposer and seconder) before or at the Annual General Meeting.

10. Special General Meeting
Upon receipt by him of a written requisition stating its purpose and signed by at least 15 members, a special General Meeting shall be convened by the Hon. Secretary after due notice has been given to all members of the Club.

11. Alterations in Bye-Laws, Resolutions,

etc.

Bye-Laws shall not be altered or fresh ones be made without the consent of two-thirds of the members at a General Meeting. Resolutions shall require a majority decision.

12. Auditor

The Annual Statement of Accounts, Balance Sheet shall be audited in accordance with the Welsh Rugby Union requirements.

13. International Tickets

International Tickets
International Tickets shall be distributed on an equitable basis by the Committee to all members. All members desirous of tickets must apply to the Hon. Secretary fourteen days prior to the game. All monies must be paid on receipt of tickets.

14. Disputes, Interpretations of Bye-Laws, etc.

Any disputes arising out of or not covered by these rules shall be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be final.

15. Transfers

The transfers and permit laws are those laid down by the Welsh Rugby Union. Players requesting a transfer must state their reasons and appear before the Committee should the latter wish it.
